The Troy Arts Council is offering up to two \$1000 non-renewable merit-based scholarships to the four-year college or university of the student's choice. Monies will be sent directly to the university as soon as the student provides the council with proof of enrollment and their student ID.

Requirements:

- Must be planning to pursue a four-year college degree in the arts.
- Must have been accepted into an accredited program.
- Must have a minimum of 750 volunteer hours with the Troy Arts Council during their high school career.
- Must have a minimum cumulative unweighted GPA of 3.25 or Homeschool equivalent academic records.
- Must be a resident of Latah County.
- Deadline to apply: July 1, 2022 (Scholarship recipients will be announced at the closing performance of The Troy Community Theatre's Summer Musical Performance.)
- Please submit an essay, 300-500 words, describing your future plans and what has led you to this career choice.
- Please submit your resume of accomplishments during your high school career. Include activities, awards, work experience, and community service.
